Request for 臨床研究認定者制度 certificate renewal by APRIN program

A certificate of 臨床研究認定者制度 is valid for two years as prescribed in Rules for 臨床研究認定者制度 in Nagoya University Graduate School of Medicine and University Hospital. In order to extend its validity, you need to renew the certificate by taking courses provided by APRIN, which requires to take the designated 7 courses within a fiscal year of expiration. Please follow the instruction below to enroll in the courses.

- ◆Enrolling in APRIN courses and obtaining a course completion certificate
 - 1. Fill in the application form
 - Download here: http://www.nu-camcr.org/cms/index.php/download-file/view/556/
 - 2. Each department should collect and email its applicants' forms to Advanced Medicine Support Section at Management Planning Division
 - 3. User ID and password will be emailed by Management Planning Division to each applicant within 2 weeks
 - 4. Log into APRIN Japan with the User ID and password provided. Password must be changed immediately once you are logged in.
 - 5. Take the designated 7 courses indicated below and finish the quizzes at the end of each course. Minimum passing score of 80% must be achieved to obtain a course completion certificate. The quizzes can be retaken until you meet the passing score.
